MOVE TO THE EMERGENCY SERVICES HEADQUARTERS

December sees the CFS Foundation move into the new South Australian Emergency Services Headquarters, located at 33 Richmond Road, Keswick.

The purpose-built facility will see the headquarters for the Country Fire Service (CFS), Metropolitan Fire Service (MFS), State Emergency Service (SES), and the South Australian Fire and Emergency Services Commission (SAFECOM) co-located for the first time.

The facility has been designed to withstand natural disasters, such as earthquakes and flood events with provisions for backup power, water as well as wastewater storage and means our Emergency Services Sector (ESS) personnel will be better prepared for catastrophic events like bushfires, floods and storms.

The new headquarters and State Control Centre is a much-needed facility for the Emergency Services Sector and will provide enhanced technology for staff and volunteers in their incredibly important roles.
